We provide free help to you and your child. You are each unique and precious, created in God's image and loved by Him.

Located in the Northwest suburbs of Chicago, we provide practical, emotional and spiritual support to you through pregnancy and childbirth:

- Housing in a safe, family-style home
- Healthy meals
- Counseling services
- Spiritual guidance
- Parenting and life skills classes
- Access to medical care

- Privacy and confidentiality

We welcome women at any stage of pregnancy and for an appropriate amount of time after your child is born. We will help you choose the best path for both you and your child going forward, and will work with you to plan for a safe and stable home later on.



Frequently-Asked Questions

Where is the Martha and Mary House located?

- We are in the Northwest Suburbs of Chicago and do not disclose our address.

Must I be an Orthodox Christian to be a part of the House?

- As the only Orthodox maternity home in the country, we are uniquely suited to help Orthodox women in need. However, we help all women, regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, social background or marital status.

What does it cost to live in the Martha and Mary Maternity House?

- There is no fee to live in the house, and we will gladly provide for your basic needs while you reside with us. (See the list to the left.)

What is expected of the House's residents?

- Living together as a family, we see the residents as our "daughters" and expect that they will participate in the life of the family home. We pray together, study together, work and dine together, and we share home responsibilities.
- Daughters are expected to continue their education or career preparation or to work during the days, and to abide by basic rules of the house.

Do I have to place my child for adoption if I live in the house?

- We encourage moms to consider adoption as a courageous and selfless choice, but it is up to each mother to make either an adoption or a parenting plan.
- To help with this decision, we provide parenting and adoption planning classes.
